

"Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men."

After a lifetime of struggling to catch fish from the Sea of Galilee and building a business with Simon and Andrew, Zebedee surely hoped his sons, James and John, would take over and relieve him of the labor of casting nets into the Sea and the dangers of the life of a fisher-

man. Then a man comes along and calls his sons to become *fishers of men* and they drop his nets and leave him. James and John could not have known what awaited them. Their mother apparently thought Jesus would establish an earthly kingdom and asked that her sons sit at his side. But it is Zebedee, with the wisdom that sometimes comes with age, who understood the real implications and challenges of the invitation of Jesus to his sons to become *fishers of men*; to be men who by what they say and do challenge others to do good and avoid evil; who choose right rather than wrong; who imitate Jesus and accept the consequences. Zebedee must have been pleased with his sons. Are we prepared to be *fishers of men* to lead others to God by imitating Jesus?




PRESENTATION OF THE LORD


