Jesus was sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers.

St. Luke tells us of the journey of Jesus as a young boy to the great city of Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. With Joseph and Mary, their family and friends, including children his age, Jesus traveled from Nazareth and shared the rigors and dangers for the four day journey. Jesus would have played games with the other children along the way. They had to protect themselves; make camp each night; and cook food; rise early; break camp and continue traveling. In Jerusalem there would be many groups like them camped in the hills surrounding the City. After the Feast, Jesus was attracted to the teachers in the Temple precincts who had studied the Law of Moses for many years. They were amazed by the wisdom of such a young boy, and the depth of his understanding of the God of all Creation. When Joseph and Mary realized Jesus was not with them, they returned to find Him in the Temple. They chided him for staying behind. He responded by saying he must be about his Father's business. And so must we. Are we?
