# 2nd Sunday of Lent



#### "This is My Beloved Son, Listen to Him!"

According to tradition the "Transfiguration" took place on top of Mount Tabor, a craggy, cone shaped mountain across the lush Jezreel Valley from both Nazareth and Cana. Jesus is with three of his friends when they see him appear quite dif-

Peter and the others wanted to stay in the comfort and safety of the top of the mountain. Are we willing to get out of our comfort zone to "Do whatever he tells you."
