This coming week Wednesday is Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent. I encourage all of our parishioners to attend Holy Mass Ash Wednesday. As you know that Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent, the 40 days of preparation for the Easter season when Christians are called to deepen their spiritual lives through the practices of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. The belief is that our consistent participation in these practices — like exercise we do for our physical health — improves our spiritual well-being by stripping away all that is unnecessary and becoming more mindful of how God is working in our lives. Challenge yourself this year, and go beyond the usual practice of “giving up” something. Now is a great time to take stock of your spiritual life and to grow in it. Not sure where to start? Check out these **10 ideas**:

1. Make a commitment to read the Sunday scriptures *before* you go to Mass.
2. Sign up for an hour of Eucharist Adoration
3. Think about what you usually spend your money on. Do you buy too many clothes? Spend too much on dinner out? Pick one type of expenditure that you’ll “fast” from during Lent, and then give the money you would usually spend to a local charity.
4. Go to a weekday Mass one day during the week. Daily Masses are often more intimate and shorter than Sunday Mass.
5. Attend the Station of the Cross somewhere.
6. Spend at least one weekend or evening volunteering during Lent. Serve a meal at soup kitchen. Visit the elderly. Stock shelves at a food pantry.
7. Make a commitment to fast from insensitive, cruel comments about others. So, no gossiping or going down the Twitter rabbit hole.
8. Use the rice bowl to reflect on the realities of people in need around the world and devote prayers, fasting, and almsgiving to changing the lives of the poor.
9. Get to know your neighbors. Introduce yourself, plan a dinner, or bring food to an older person on your block.
10. Celebrate the Sacrament of reconciliation.

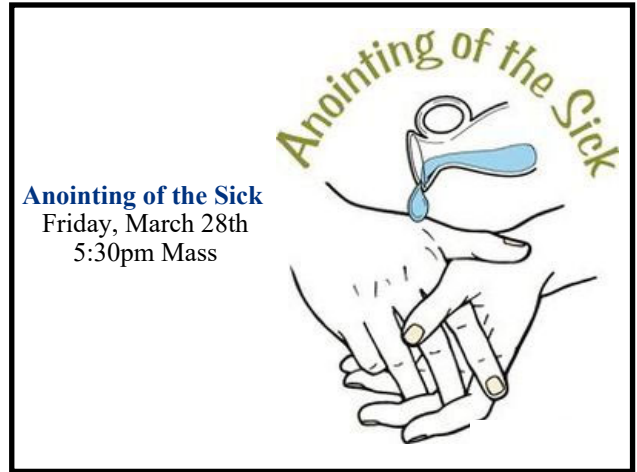

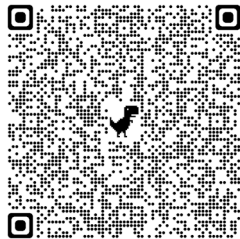
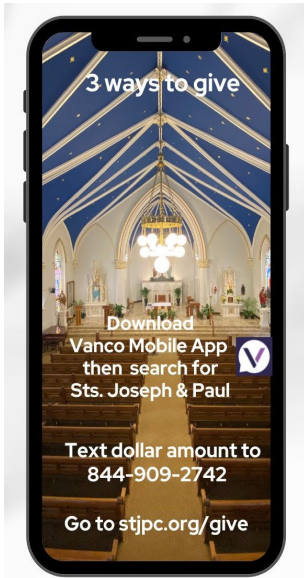
Nominations & Elections of Parish Pastoral Council Members

As many of you recall in 2012 and in connection with the 125th anniversary of our parish, Fr. Carl Mccarthy and a group of parishioners began visiting the mountain top village of Lalomas, Haiti. It was then that the parish agreed to "twin" (partner) with the two schools and St. Joseph Catholic Church on top of the mountain. As part of this commitment and support, a program of sponsoring children was put in place. This program and your generosity continues to allow us to pay 50 teachers to teach school, as prior to that time they only were paid sporadically, resulting in sporadic attendance of both teachers and students.

Upon one of our visits, we met Jemes, a 13 year old boy who was kind, caring and curious. Jemes was a sponge, soaking up all the education offered him. Remaining in contact with Jemes over the years, Lee Franey agreed to send him to high school and to English classes. Jemes was thrilled! With more and more turmoil and unrest in Haiti and with much determination Jemes and his friend Marie, were able to travel from Lalomas to the Dominican Republic and eventually made it to Mexico. Sept 20, 2024 they legally entered the United States. Jemes and Marie were finally safe from Haiti violence and gangs, as well as the prejudice they experienced in the Dominican Republic. Today Jemes and Marie live in Owensboro. He is employed and studying to obtain his drivers license and they are expecting their 1st child in June.

If you speak with Jemes you will witness his "attitude of gratitude." He is so very grateful to Sts. Joseph and Paul Parish for supporting him through grade school, as well as the other children and teachers. Because of you, Jemes and his young family have the hope of a future that would not have happened otherwise. God has gifted us with the ability of witnessing the fruits of our labor and a beautiful success story. And so we share Jemes' "attitude of gratitude".

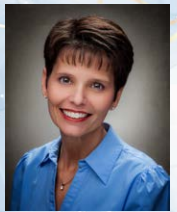

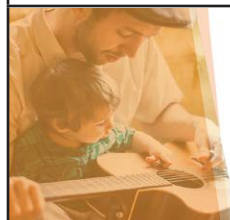
