Reading the passion of Jesus, I am struck by the fact that the crowd changed quickly their mood. ( from Sunday to Friday ). On Palm Sunday, they When welcomed Jesus with joy when He entered into Jerusalem. They were happy to receive Jesus singing Hosanna, Hosanna.... Son of David.... Blessed be the one who comes in the name of the

Lord. But few days later the same crowd changed their mood . They turned against Jesus crying out crucify him, crucify him. So, the question is , what happened ? What happened from Sunday through Friday ? What happened in their lives ? What happened to their faith ? The only reason was their praise was superficial...Their support for Jesus was only skin deep. They praise Jesus by their lips but their hearts were empty. What about you and I? How does the passion speak to us? It was easy to be part of a crowd that welcomed Jesus when we proclaim our faith, and when we pray. Also, it was easy to be part of a crowd that condemned him to death when we judge others. It is easy to be part of the crowd when we receive the sacraments, especially, the Eucharist. But How many of that crowd come to meet Jesus during Mass every Sunday? It is easy to be part of the crowd who welcomed Jesus when read the scripture. But how many of us we deny him when we are not sensitive to the needs of others. Do not waste this week. Spend this week with Jesus meditating on his Passion. I extend a personal invitation to everyone to come to the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday and Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night


#### **Word of Life**
