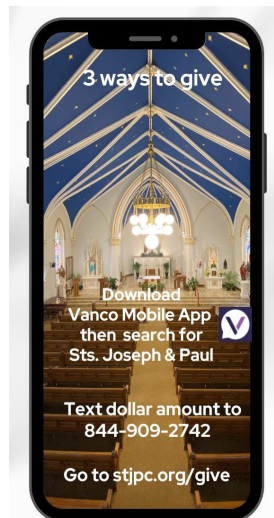

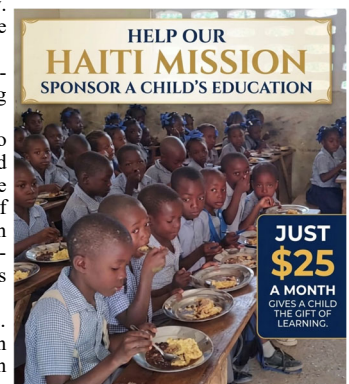
Introducing the Fr Jean-Rene Emmanuel, pastor of our sister parish in Lalomas, Haiti

I am Jean-Robert Emmanuel, I was born in Cap-Haïtien, the second city of the country. I was born on November 23, 1987 into a Catholic family. Orphaned of my mother at the age of 12, orphaned of my father at the age of 24.

I completed my primary studies at the College Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Cap-Haïtien with the religious of Holy Cross and my secondary studies at Christ the King College.

After spending 3 years on the path with the religious of Sainte Croix, I was admitted to the postulancy in Fort Liberté to begin initial formation on October 4, 2009. I studied philosophy and theology and spent a total of 10 years within the community of the religious of Sainte Croix. I was appointed for a pastoral internship at the parish of Saint Michael the Archangel of Saint Michel de l'Attalaye, where I spent 2 years as an intern. (St. Michel is 30 minutes from Lalomas.) I was ordained deacon on Holy Thursday, April 6, 2023, and I was ordained priest on October 15, 2023. I spent 2 years as vicar at the parish of Saint Michael the Archangel.

In September 2025, I was appointed as the pastor of the Saint Joseph parish in Lalomas. What motivated me to become a priest is an education in faith, a human education, an intellectual education. Bringing as many people as possible closer to God. I believe in the spirit of mutual aid, participation, collaboration, and communion.

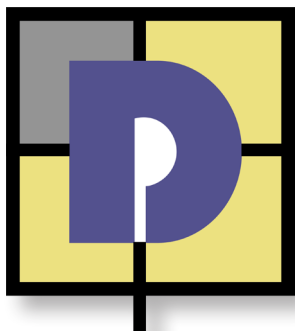
