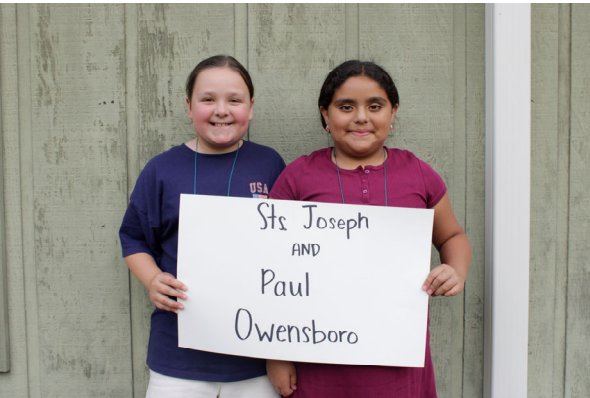

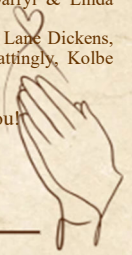

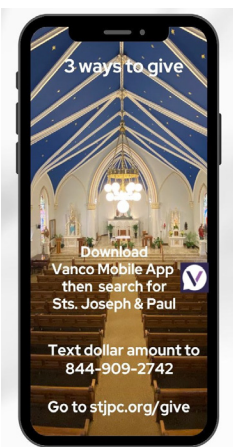

July 1, 2026, marked the beginning of our new fiscal year.

We closed the 2025–2026 fiscal year with a regular collection deficit of \$119,001.70. As part of our ongoing efforts to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to us, the 2026–2027 regular collection budget has been reduced by \$115,000. Even with this reduction, we will still need an additional \$31,000 in revenue to meet our budgeted operating expenses for the 2026–2027 fiscal year.

We sincerely thank you for your continued generosity and faithful support of our parish. Your stewardship makes our ministries and mission possible.

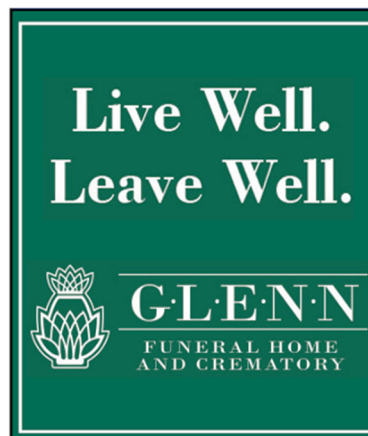
