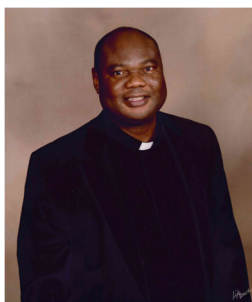

The story of today's gospel is unique in many ways. I've never seen Jesus responded to someone in need like he did. The first time I read this Gospel passage, I was shocked. I was shocked by the way Jesus treated the Canaanite woman at the beginning. He ignored her. He ignored her request. The most struck me, is when Jesus said to her that it is not good to give the food of the children to the dogs. Treating her as a dog. But at the end of the story, Jesus praised her for her faith saying, Oh woman, great is your faith. To understand the message, to understand what Jesus wants to teach us, we need to see the context and the background. The encounter with the Canaanite took place in Tyre and Sidon, pagan territory. In Jesus' time, there was a prejudice against gentiles that they were not able to have a relationship with God. In addition, they were regarded by the Jewish people as enemies and ritually unclean. That is why the Jews avoided to go to the pagan territory or to be in contact with them. Because they considered themselves chosen people, people of God, the only ones to be saved. That was the reason they despised others no Jews. In this context, the Canaanite met Jesus and said: Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David. My daughter is tormented by a demon. Jesus first ignores her. In reply He said to her;

I was sent only to the lost sheep of the house of Israel, Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David. But at the end Jesus praised her, woman, great is your faith. Let it be done for you as you wish. So, Jesus crossed the cultural boundaries. First of all, He went to pagan territory to demonstrate that God's love and mercy are for all the peoples, not just for the Jewish. Salvation is for all people, not just for chosen people. God does not discriminate but welcome all who believe in Him, who ask for His mercy and who try to do His will. By healing the woman's child, Jesus shows that his mission is to break down the barriers and remove the walls of division and mutual prejudice between the Jews and the gentiles. Now the situation of Jesus' time is not different from what we see today. Because in our world, exist discrimination, racism, intolerance and division even among believers. And the tendency is to judge people. But as followers of Jesus, we are called to pull down our walls of separation, walls of intolerance, walls of prejudice and see everyone as God sees them. As Christians, we are asked to deal with other people in truth, not according to the prejudice or labels, which we find in our environment. If we claim to be believers, we must not say, this is the way Jews are, or this is the way Moslems are, or this is the way, or this is the way Hispanics are. So instead of letting our lives be directed by the prejudices, we are called to discover the real people God has made. Jesus is challenging everyone because no one is perfect. Jesus is challenging every culture, because salvation is for all the peoples who come to God with faith. That is why we should pray that the walls which our pride, intolerance and prejudice have raised, may crumble. Hopefully, I encourage you to do something special at least for one person during this week. Maybe you can call someone you don't like to talk or to greet. Or you can say an extra prayer for him. So, let us pray with perseverance like the Canaanite and have the courage to cross the cultural boundaries like Jesus.

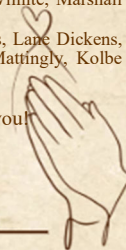

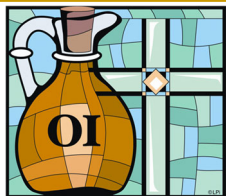

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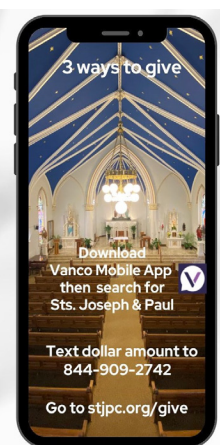
