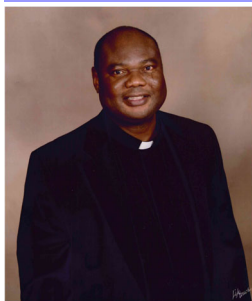

Give them to eat. Today's gospel is about compassion and sharing. Compassion moves us to share the blessings God has given us. Compassion moves us to act, to do something for those in need. And when we share what we have, miracle happens. This is what happened in the story of feeding thousand in the desert.

Jesus performed the miracle from 5 loaves and 2 fish. Jesus is God. Why did not Jesus produce bread from nothing to feed the crowd? Because God needs our five loaves and two fish in order to perform the miracle of feeding the five thousand. Many people in this world depend of our

generosity. Many people depend of our sharing. God needs our 5 loaves and 2 fish. He needs our time, our talents and our giving in order to perform the miracle to feed the hungry in the world. This is the message we take from today's gospel. Give them to eat. Today, Jesus is addressing the same message, the same order to everyone. And He says: Joseph: Give them to eat. Mary, feed the hungry. Saints Joe and Paul community takes care of those in need. Yes, give them to eat. We do a wonderful job and I am so proud to see compassionate parishioners feeding the homeless at Saint Benedict. Because of their compassion they give their time, food to feed the hungry. We do a wonderful job and I am very thankful to see compassionate people in our Parish giving their money to Saint Vincent the Paul. Compassionate people who give their time, money to support Haiti. We do a wonderful job to feed the hungry. This is our mission as followers of Jesus. Remember what Jesus says to the apostles: Give them to eat. Do something. Remember what Jesus says in the parable of the good Samaritan: Go and do likewise.

Yes, we do a wonderful job to share our blessings. But we can do more. Because there are still people who die for hunger meanwhile there is enough for everyone in the world. It is a shame that in 2026, there are still brothers and sisters, body of Christ who die for hunger meanwhile others people have more than what they need. Maybe we don't give what we suppose to give. Maybe we need to be more sensitive to the needs of the poor. Brothers and sisters, today's gospel is a challenge for everyone. We cannot read today's gospel and remain the same people. Compassion moves us to act, to do something for the poor. Today, God needs our five loaves and 2 fish to feed those who are hungry.

Remember that God needs your 5 loaves and 2 fish in order to make the miracle possible to feed those who are hungry of love. God needs your 5 loaves to feed those who are hungry of peace. How many brothers and sisters want to live in peace but they are afraid. God needs your 5 loaves and 2 fish in order to feed those who are hungry of justice. How many brothers and sisters cry for justice. God needs your 5 loaves and 2 fish in order to feed those who are hungry of happiness. How many couples, brothers and sisters, families who want to be happy. Give them to eat. Today God needs your 5 loaves and 2 fish in order to feed those who are hungry of God. How many brothers and sisters who need to fill their hearts with the word of God. These hungry people, we know them. They are family members. They are brothers and sisters in our family, in our community, in our job. We know them. They need our compassion and our sharing. Give them to eat. So, giving is an investment to God. All we give to the poor will be rewarded. In our prayer, we ask God for grace to be more sensitive to the needs of others.

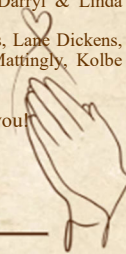

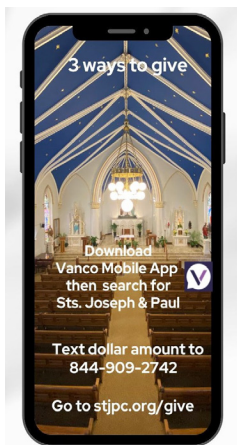

Saints Joseph And Paul Parish Income & Expenses 2025-26

July 1, 2026, marked the beginning of our new fiscal year.

We closed the 2025–2026 fiscal year with a regular collection deficit of \$119,271.70. As part of our ongoing efforts to be good stewards of the resources entrusted to us, the 2026–2027 regular collection budget has been reduced by \$115,000. Even with this reduction, we will still need an additional \$31,000 in revenue to meet our budgeted operating expenses for the 2026–2027 fiscal year.

We sincerely thank you for your continued generosity and faithful support of our parish. Your stewardship makes our ministries and mission possible.
