A Message From Fr. Kalombo

In our first reading, God says to the prophet Ezekiel: You, son of man, I have appointed watchman for the house of Israel. As Christians we are keepers of our brothers and sisters. Because as members of the body of Christ, we have to care about those who are not coming to the Church. We have to check on them if they are doing well. We are keepers of those who are far from God. We have to worry about those who are sick or facing hard time. As watchmen, we have social responsibility to take care of the hungry, the homeless, and the needy people no matter where they come from. That is why we help in Saint Vincent the Paul, Haiti and Saint Benedict. Thank you for your generosity. In doing so, we show our solidarity to the members of the Body of Christ in need. As keepers of our brothers and sisters, we have a spiritual responsibility to one another to make sure that everyone is behaving in a Christian way. That is why Jesus says in the gospel that if your brother did something wrong, go to talk to him. Go to correct him in a loving way. It is our mission to say to those who commit injustice, violence, hatred to stop. Because they are destroying the human beings, the temple of the Holy Spirit. It is our duty, our mission to correct those who are lost, those who are destroying families. It is our duty to tell our friends, young to stop destroying their bodies with alcohol, or drugs. It is our duty to tell our friends to stop spreading gossip or division. But if we keep silence, if we don't do anything to correct them, God will hold us responsible for their death. Our first reading says; If you do not speak out to dissuade the wicked from his way, the wicked shall die for his guilt, but I will hold you responsible for his death. As missionary disciples, we have a responsibility to those who stop believing in God. We have the responsibility to those who don't come to Church. We have to worry about those who have left Catholic Church. We have the mission to do something for the young people who are lost in drugs, in smoking, in alcoholism, and are involved in bad crowds. If your brother or sister does something wrong, you need to go to correct him. It is our responsibility. It is your responsibility. It is a command. Jesus says, go to talk to him. Let us be the source of hope and encouragement for one another.
